'This teak cladding contrasts well with the tub's copper interior, which is carried across on to the bathroom accessories,' says Brian Athey, general manager of Hurlingham The Bath Company. 'The wood finish puts a modern twist on what would be a very traditional bathroom and we chose this unusual highly textured wallpaper to work as a striking backdrop to the fixtures.' 'Chrome accessories and the glossy tiled floor amplify the effect of the Usk bath's mirrorpolished exterior,' says Drummond Shaw, founder and chairman of bathroom specialist Drummonds. 'Marble is used on the washstand and as a wall panel to define the shower – with no enclosure, this becomes a statement of paredback elegance.'
