### How to pick the right ENCLOSURE

FAYE FROY, MARKETING MANAGER AT ARCADE BATHROOMS, OFFERS HER EXPERT TIPS:

- When planning where to put your shower, measure and mark where your windows, doors and any other fixed elements of the room are. This will help you understand how much room to have to work with and help you figure our what type of enclosure and door option works best for your bathroom scheme.
- Take time to explore all the options make sure you choose something that is going to work both practically and aesthetically. If you're looking for something that is clean and contemporary and have the space, a recessed shower unit is a great way to transform unused wall space. If your room is smaller, a quadrant shower is an excellent way of saving floor space and is a great alternative to the more traditional square or rectangular-shaped enclosures.
- Think about the surrounding space. This is how you will be able to understand which door option will work best for your bathroom. Make sure you measure exactly how much room there is for a door to open if you are opting for a hinge door and check there won't be any obstructions that will cause problems once it's all fitted. If you are short on surrounding space, there are a number of other options, from sliders to simple walk-in screens that don't require any movement.
