

1 When crafting the 'Minnewaska' chandelier (\$14,400) from silver, Jonah Meyer of Sawkille Co channels the skills of his father, a smith who also worked the soft and luminescent metal. Ring 001 845 217 7890, or visit sawkille.com.

2 If these plates seem familiar it's because the two patterns, 'Chawton Rosebud Moiré' (top) and 'Chawton Vine', have appeared on these pages before as wallpapers. (They were copied by Hamilton Weston using 19th-century scraps found at Jane Austen's House Museum in Hampshire.) 3 Jamb has a knack for fashioning fabulous reproductions, be it a fireplace or, as here, furniture. The Regency-style 'Albury' sofa (top) is available in various finishes, including the aged painted one shown, while

4 Like the gods and goddesses that grace some of his seven 17.5 × 29cm 'Roma' trays (\$128 each), John Derian's découpage wares are omnipresent – with very good reason. His obsession with printed matter ultimately led him to establish a studio in New York, where artisans practise the art of cutting and pasting paper to create the finest such decorative accessories.
