

Q&A JAMES LENTAIGNE CREATIVE DIRECTOR AT DRUMMONDS

What are the main considerations for a guest bathroom? Guest bathrooms are often treated as an afterthought, making them questionably hospitable. We should take our lead from hotel bathrooms to make friends and family who are overnighting or spending a little longer feel that their bathroom has been carefully planned to offer maximum function in a relaxing, good-looking and well-designed environment.

How can we make it as inviting and as welcoming as possible? If you are reconfiguring space to create a guest bathroom, give it as much room as you can. It will allow you the luxury of choosing a spacious shower and perhaps even double basins or a feature bath. Make sure there are obvious shelves where guests can unpack their toiletries. Screen the windows properly for privacy and have good, adjustable lighting, especially around mirrors. Choose quality mirrors, particularly above basins. A bathroom radiator will heat the space as well as keeping towels toasty. Underfloor heating is a must-have for tiled floors.

What are the latest trends in products, colours or materials? Taking the lead from boutique hotels, we are all upping the guest bathroom specification and it's no longer a 'second best' space. At Drummonds, we've created more compact versions of many of our most-loved pieces, from baths to vanity basins, and these are increasingly being used to create luxurious guest en-suites.
