CLASSIC LUXURY

'In this room, the bath has been positioned directly in front of a fabulous floor-to-ceiling window so that the rolling parkland can be viewed,' explains Ottalie Stride, creative director, Albion Nord. The oval Colette bathtub, from £14,112, Waterworks, sits next to a central vanity unit, which conceals the WC and shower, with the floor and wall clad in Calacatta Vagli marble to enhance the classic elegance of the scheme.

GOLDEN GLOW

'We chose the brass Usk as it's the biggest and most golden bath offered by Drummonds,' says Mitch Crook, creative director, Hotel Creative. 'It needed to complement the gold shower, as both are a central focus of this room.' With the hand-painted antiqued gold St Laurent wallpaper by de Gournay and ceiling finished in gold leaf, the look is undeniably opulent. The Usk bateau bath clad in brass, £10,740, Drummonds.

1. WONDER WALL

'Incorporating wallpaper into your bathroom scheme, even in a small section, can create a huge visual impact,' says Joel Fry, designer, West One Bathrooms. The company's Wet System wallpaper offerings include this superb botanical Ubud, £214m, with all glues and sealants provided.

2. VINTAGE CHARM

Reclaimed from a hacienda in Spain, these tiles, from £210sq m, Maitland & Poate, bring character to the slender space. 'The aged patina and dusky caramel tones complement the textures, adding just the right amount of luxurious drama,' says Mark Lewis, director, Mark Lewis Interior Design.

3. SOFT OPTION

'Bathrooms are home to many hard materials, so Tadelakt, a natural lime-based plaster, is the perfect way to soften the look,' says Irene Gunter, co-founder, Gunter & Co Interiors. 'It adds texture with its raw, earthy aesthetic and create a seamless, hard-wearing and waterproof surface.'

4. MODERN DRAMA

'We love these extra-large tiles as grout lines are minimised,' says the owner of this bathroom. 'The colour combined with the warm elegant brass creates an essential sense of opulence.' Blue Onice 240x120cm porcelain tiles, £204sq m, Tile by Tile. Unlacquered brass fittings, Drummonds.
