


## ▶ Retrouvius

### Design notes

### Nuts and bolts

Handmade wallpaper sheets, wall-light shades made from vintage *aso oke* cloth from Nigeria and Sierra Leone, vintage wall-hung mirror and antique mahogany shaving mirror, reclaimed freestanding bath, basin and Moroccan rug, all from Retrouvius. ## ◀ Wolterton

### Design notes

This handsome bathroom in Wolterton Hall is beautifully furnished and hung with artwork, so it feels like a decorated space. Despite being a carefully considered scheme (the colour of the bath was inspired by a Stanley Spencer painting), the wooden floorboards and the arrangement of the rugs give it an unpretentious look.

### Nuts and bolts

Vanity washstand and mahogany loo seat, from Mongers Architectural Salvage. For a similar claw-foot bath, try Drummonds. Walls painted in 'Natterjack', and bath painted in 'Shepherd's Delight', both from Fenwick & Tilbrook

## ▶ Drummonds

### Design notes

This bathroom was reimaged by the team at Harding & Read (before the designers went their separate ways) to feel like a comfortable sanctuary, using warm, earthy colours and rich textures. The spacious conversation-seat sofa in the centre of the room is ideal for a family with children.
