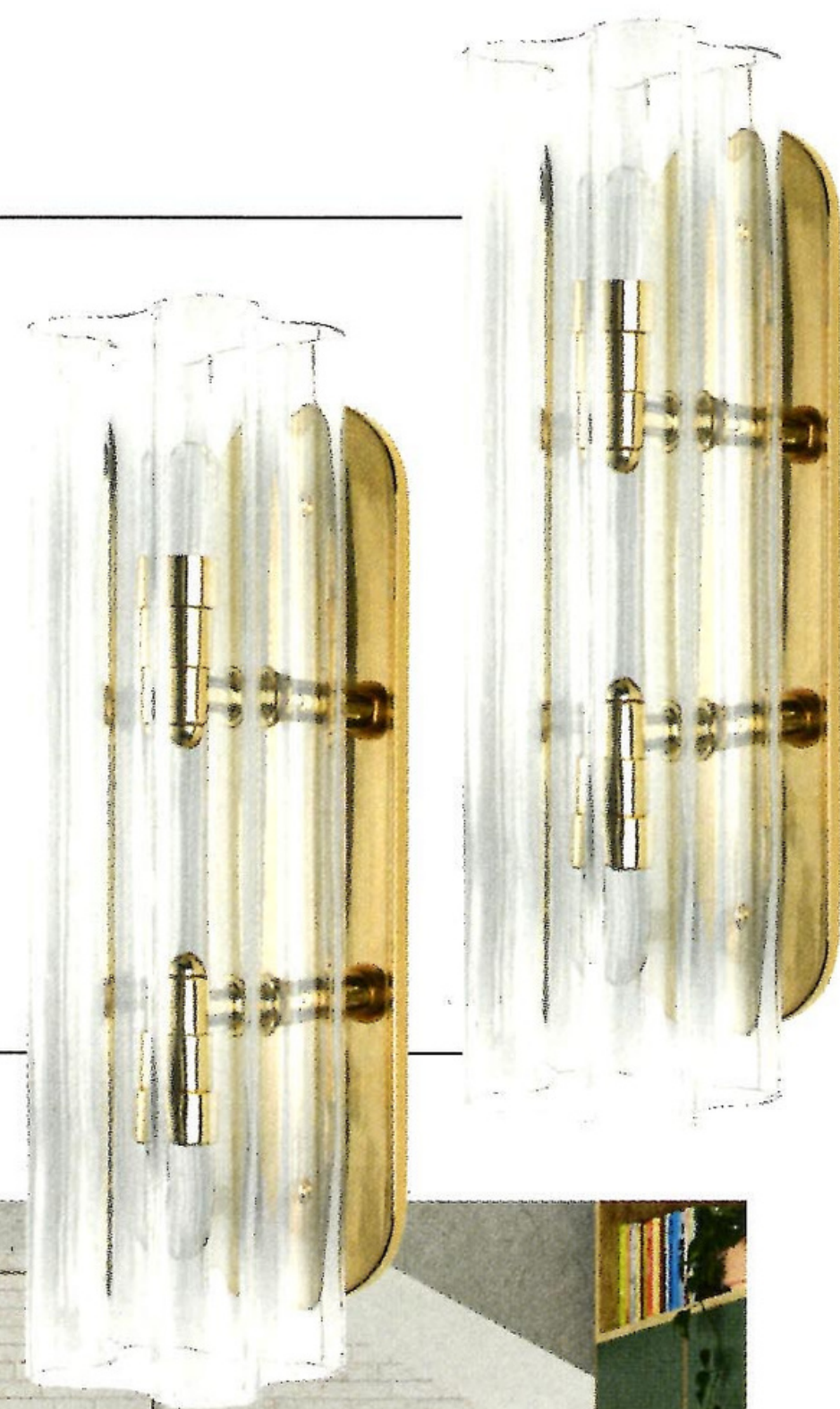
## COOL COLLAB
